- (d) Do you find any influence of another country on the literature of ancient Rome?

- 3. Examine the moment of *anagnorsis* in *Oedipus Rex*. Give illustrations/examples to substantiate your answer.
- 4. Who reports the conditions of Thebes? What do you they have to say about the condition in the city? Illustrate your answer with examples from the text.

- 5. Critically analyse *Pot of Gold*'s assessment of the society of its time. Give examples.
- 6. Examine the significance of the slaves in *Pot of Gold*.
- 7. 'Strobilus desires freedom.' Would you agree?

  Is this desire for freedom fulfilled? Give reasons for your answer.
- 8. Did Horace's father contribute to his role as a satirist?
