Primary education consists of the first years of formal, structured education. In general, primary education consists of six or seven years of schooling starting at the age of 5 or 6, although this varies between and sometimes

within countries. Globally, around 70% of primary age children are enrolled in primary education and this proportion is rising.

In most contemporary educational systems of the world, secondary education consists of the second years of formal education that occur during adolescence. It is characterised by the transition from the typically compulsory, comprehensive primary education for minors, to the optional selective tertiary. 'Post-secondary' or 'higher' education (e.g. University, Vocational School) for adults.

Higher education also called tertiary third stage or post-secondary is normally taken to include undergraduate and post-graduate education as well as vocational education and training colleges and universities are the main institutions that provide tertiary education. Collectively, these are known as tertiary institutions. Tertiary education generally results in the receipt of certificates, diploma or academic degrees.

Formal education consists of systematic instruction, teaching and training by professional teachers. This consists of the application of pedagogy and development of curricula.
