1. Write short notes on any *four* of the following:

- (i) The difference between speaking and writing skills.
- (ii) Approaches to Grammar teaching.
- (iii) Can writing skill be taught?
- (iv) How to monitor our classes?
- (v) Interactional and Transactional function of language.
- (vi) Difference between critical and creative reading.

- 2. Reading comprehension is an active process. Discuss, using concepts such as 'Scheme theory', 'Prediction' and so on.
- 3. Discuss the direct and indirect approach to teaching the speaking skill. Suggest *two* activities for each of these approaches.
- 4. What kind of language activities lend themselves to group work in the classroom? How would you organize and monitor group work in your classroom? Give advantages of group work.
- 5. Using the process based and interactive approach to writing, help children of class 8 to write a composition on 'My Earth, My Responsibility'. You must go through each stage of the Process Approach.
- 6. What are the enabling skills for the listening skill? Describe the different phases of a listening lesson in the classroom. Give an example of *one* listening activity and how you would conduct this activity in the classroom. 20
- 7. Think of any English Reader that is used in schools. Clearly mention the title of the Reader and the class it is used for. Prepare a lesson plan for one of lessons in that Reader.
