**Dear Learner,**

As we have informed you in the Programme Guide, evaluation at IGNOU consists of two parts: i) continuous evaluation through assignments, and ii) term-end examination. In the final result, assignments of a Course will carry 30% weightage (total 100 marks) while 70% weightage is given for term-end examination.

**BPCC 132** is a 6 credits course (4 credits theory + 2 credits tutorial). Assignment for BPCC 132 consists of two parts.

**Part I** consists of Assignment one and Assignment two.

Assignment One has Descriptive Category Questions (DCQs). These are meant for writing essay type answers, with an introduction and a conclusion. These are intended to test your ability to describe your understanding/knowledge about the topic in a systematic, to-the-point and coherent manner.

Assignment Two has Short Category Questions (SCQs). These questions are meant to improve your skill of recall in brief the relevant/precise information about persons, writing, events, or clear understanding of concepts and processes.

**Part II** has Tutorial component in which the learner has to carry out a particular activity as instructed.

**Before you attempt the assignments, please read the instructions carefully provided in the Programme Guide.** It is important that you write the answers to all the TMA questions in **your own words**. Your answers should be according to the word-limit set for a particular section. Remember, writing answers to assignment questions will improve your writing skill and sharpen your understanding of the concepts. It will also help you prepare for the term-end examination.

  - i. **Planning:** Read the assignments carefully. Go through the Units on which they are based. Make some points regarding each question and then re-arrange these in a logical order.
  - ii. **Organisation:** Read the study material carefully, analyze it, and then prepare a rough outline of your answer. Give adequate attention to your introduction and conclusion. Make sure that your answer:
    - a) is logical and coherent;
    - b) has clear connections between sentences and paragraphs;
    - c) is written correctly giving adequate consideration to your expression, style and presentation
  - iii. **Presentation:** Once you are satisfied with your answers, you can write down the final version for submission. Write each answer neatly with proper spacing, and underline the points you wish to emphasize. Make sure that the answer is around the suggested word limit.
2. Use A4 size ruled paper for your response and tie all the pages carefully. Allow a 4 cm margin on the left and leave some space between each answer. This will facilitate the evaluator to write useful comments in the margin at appropriate places.
3. **Answers should be in your own handwriting.** Do not print or type the answers. Do not copy your answers from the study material sent to you by the University or from other learners. If you copy, you will get zero marks for the respective question.
4. You need to attach a copy of the TMA with the completed assignment before submitting it.
5. In case you have requested for a change of Study Centre, you should submit your Tutor Marked Assignments only to the original Study Centre until the change of Study Centre is notified by the University.
6. **PART I- Assignment - One**

**Answer the following *descriptive category* questions in about 500 words each. Each question carries 20 marks.** 2 x 20=40

1. Describe the components of culture and discuss the agents of enculturation (5+ 15)
2. Discuss the types of communication and communication style. Describe the barriers of effective communication.

**Assignment Two**

**Answer the following *short category* questions in about 100 words each. Each question carries 5 marks.**

3. Explain the types and components of group. (5)
4. Describe the factors affecting conformity and its resistance. (5)
5. Discuss the motivation behind pro-social behavior. (5)
6. Explain the causes of aggression. (5)
7. Explain sources of errors in social cognition. (5)
8. Describe the historical development of psychology. (5)

## **PART II: Tutorial (1x30= 30)**

Q. Prepare an interview schedule to examine the impact of bullying behavior on the attitude and behavior of school students who have been the victims of bullying (e.g. it may involve questions related to whether they have ever been the victims of bullying at school, the type of bullying the victims have suffered and how has it impacted on their peer relations, performance, relations with parents etc ). You will have to collect the data only from those students who have been bullied ever in school. You will have to follow all the ethics of research (e.g. maintaining confidentiality). Collect your responses through interview survey on the following groups:

1. Primary School students (Age group 6-12yrs)
2. Secondary School Students (Age group 13- 18 yrs)

Based on the collected information, you will also have to suggest the ways that can reduce the impact of bullying on the above mentioned age groups.

On basis of the responses received, you have to write the activity in the following format:

1. You will prepare a handwritten file (of A4 sheets) with a brief introduction of the topic (as given) and a discussion on the responses and the trends received through interviewing the participants. You have to conclude the survey on basis of the facts and findings.
2. You need to enclose the filled in questionnaire (raw data) also in the file.
3. On basis of the selected topic, you need to prepare atleast 10-15 questions for the interview schedule.
4. A sample size of minimum 20 participants (10 school children of primary level and 10 of secondary level, who have been the victims of bullying at school) need to be included for the survey.
5. The file/ notebook will include the following subsections:
  - i) **Introduction** (of about 200 words)
  - ii) **Methodology** (which will include the details about the sample size and the method of data collection in about 150 words)
  - iii) **Findings** (of about 200 words)
  - iv) **Conclusion and Suggestion** (of about 150 words)
