- a) Planning: Read the assignment carefully. Go through the units on which they are based.Makesomepointsregardingeachquestionandthenrearrangetheseinalogicalorderinyourownwords.
- b) Organisation: Be a little more selective and analytical before drawing up a rough outline of your answer. In an essay-type question, give adequate attention to your introduction and and and another introduction must offer your brief interpretation of the question and howyouproposetodevelop it. The conclusion must summarise your response to the question.

Makesurethatyouranswer:

- o islogical and coherent;
- o hasclearconnections between sentences and paragraphs;
- o iswrittencorrectlygivingadequate considerationtoyourexpression, style and presentation;
- o doesnotexceedthe numberofwords indicated in your question.
- a) **Presentation:** Once you are satisfied with your answers, you can write down the final version forsubmission, writing each answerneatly and underlining the points you wish to emphasis.
- **b) Interpretation:** Interpretation is a constant process in history writing. It is already reflected in yourplanning and selection. Explanatory comments with phrases like may be, because, could be, etc., immediately introduce an element of interpretation inwriting itself. Here you have to be carefulthat these comments can be supported by the material you have in the answer.
