- c) Is written correctly giving adequate consideration to your expression, style and presentation
- d) Does not exceed the number of words indicated in the question.
- 3) Presentations: Once you are satisfied with your answers, you can write down the final version for submission, writing each answer neatly and underline the points you wish to emphasize.
