  - What civil remedies are available in the case (b) of infringement of a patent. Be brief.
  - Briefly mention the purpose of the PCT. (c)
  - How does the European patent office (d) interpret the term ' inventive step'?
  - What is the principle of National Treatment (e) under TRIPs Agreement?
  - Can an industrial design, which is solely (f) dictated by the function to be performed by the article to which it is applied, be protected?

- (g) What is the minimum duration of protection of the Breeder's Right under the 1991 UPOV convention?
- (h) What is a 'seri generis' system?
- (i) What is the minimum documentation prescribed under the PCT, which an International Searching Authority is required to maintain and follow in its search?
- (j) What is an International Depository Authority under the Berdapest Treaty?

  - (a) How is 'deliberate' infringement different from 'accidental' infringement? Discuss the main exceptions, found in most laws to infringement of the exclusive right to make a patented product.
  - (b) What are the contents of a patent application under the U.S. Patent system?
  - (c) What is the Washington Treaty, 1989, concerned with? What acts under it are considered unlawful, if performed without the authorization of the holder of the rights?
  - (d) Describe the three main features of TRIPs Agreement.

  - (a) Discuss these provisions regarding patents in the Paris Convention.
  - (b) Explain through a chart the various stages and the activities under each stage of the International Phase of the PCT.

  - (d) Write an essay on the Patenting of Microorganisms with particular reference to the Berdapest Treaty.
