Write short notes on *any four* questions of the following in about **200** words. Each question carries 5 marks.

1. Protocol to prevent, suppress and Punish Trafficking the persons, especially women and children, supplementing the convention on Transitional organised crime (2000).

2. Child welfare committee.
3. Central Anti - Trafficking Police Officer.
4. Liability of the witness who refuses to cooperate with the police .
5. Role of the Judiciary in Combating Human Trafficking.
6. Role of the Panchayat Raj Institutions in Combating Human Trafficking.

PART - B

Attempt *any four* of the following questions in about **400** words. Each question carries **10** marks.

1. Discuss the main features of the SAARC convention on preventing and combating trafficking in women and children for Postitution, 2002.
2. Evaluate the role of the police in investigating the crime of Human trafficking.
3. Discuss the challenges faced by the law enforcement agencies in identifying the victims of Human Trafficking.
4. What do you understand by witness protection ? Discuss the International and National mechanisms for witness protection.
5. Evaluate the Role of non - governmental organisations in the rescue and the rehabilitation of Human Traffick victims.
6. What is Legal Aid ? Discuss its significance for the victims of Human Trafficking.

PART - C

Answer *any two* of the following questions in about **1200** words. Each question carries **20** marks.

1. Critically analyse the constitutional and Legislative Provisions dealing with Anti - Human Trafficking. Are these provisions adequate in preventing Human Trafficking ? Discuss.
 2. Discuss the various challenges faced by the Law enforcement Agencies in curbing the menace of Human Trafficking.
 3. In the Light of decided cases, Evaluate the contribution made by the Indian Judiciary in the field of Anti - Human Trafficking.
 4. Discuss the role of Anti - Human Trafficking units of Andhra Pradesh in combating Human Trafficking.
