PART - B

Attempt *any four* questions from this part. Each question carries **10** marks (*not exceeding 400 words*). **4x10=40**

1. How do you define Multi - disciplinary approach ?
2. What are the roles of different institutions in Rehabilitation ?
3. What are the challenges in Restoration and Repatriation ?
4. Write a note on Anti Human Trafficking Unit (AHTU)
5. What are the different stages of empowerment of a vulnerable person in the context of human trafficking ?
6. Explain the current Indian good practices in reducing the supply in context of Human Trafficking.

PART - C

Attempt any 2 questions from this part. Each question carries 20 marks (*not exceeding 1200 words*) 2x20=40

1. Explain the process of Rehabilitation.
 2. How can the issues of Human Trafficking be addressed at the roots in a comprehensive manner ?
 3. Explain the role of media in Human Trafficking issues.
 4. What are the inter personal communication skills in addressing the issues of Human Trafficking ?
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
