- (d) Give a detailed description of the criticism of inference by *Cārvāka*. 10

- (a) Explain the steps of *yama* and *Niyama* in Yoga. 5
- (b) Describe the *sāmkhya* concept of *gunas*. 5
- (c) What are the eight fold path (*aṣṭāṅga marga*) of Buddhism? 5
- (d) Explain the categories of universal (*sāmānya*) and inherence (*Samavāya*) in *vaiśeṣika*. 5
- (e) Which are the *Mahāvākyas*? 5
- (f) What is the concept of evolution in Aurobindo? 5
