Salma is a 16 day old infant weighing 2.7 kg and temperature of 36°C. She is brought with boils on her body for 3 days. Salma has no convulsions, chest indrawing, grunting or nasal flare. Her respiratory rate is 48 per minute. There are 7-8 pustules over her abdomen and the umbilicus is red. Salma is alert and active but is jaundiced till thigh. There is no diarrhoea. Her mother's breast feeds her 5-6 times/day and gives undiluted cow's milk by bottle 2-3 times/day. Salma is observed to attach well to her mother's breast and was sucking effectively. Her weight for age is normal.

- (a) List all the problems that Salma has.
- (b) Discuss the treatment for each of her problems identified.
