OR

Discuss different aspects of reproductive health and hygiene during adult and married life.

3. Answer any four of the following in about 150 words each :

- (a) Causes and types of Reproductive Tract Infections (RTIs).
- (b) Relationship between Sexually Transmitted Infections/Diseases (STIs/STDs) and HIV/AIDS.
- (c) Significance of gender equity and equality for family welfare in particular and human welfare in general.
- (d) Explain the process of conception and sex determination.
- (e) Explain the need, concept and scope of population education.
- (f) Distinguish between 'population education' and 'population studies'.

Critically examine the rationale underlying institutionalisation of population and development education at different levels (school as well as college and university) of education in India.
