- What are the different types of language 20 disorders? Discuss them briefly. Write about your experience of dealing with a person with a language disorder.

- What is code-mixing and code-switching ? Give 20 examples. How would you use these aspects to make your class effective ?
- 4. What are the limitations of the behaviourist view 20 of language learning? Why do you think the Cognitivist and the Procedural Approaches are better ?
