- 3. Write down the units of measurements for the following items:
  - (a) Glazed tiles in dado
  - (b) Al glazed partition
  - (c) 40 mm thick panelled doors
  - (d) Pressed steel hollow section frame
  - (e) Half brick thick brick wall
  - (f) M.S. grill for windows
  - (g) 6 mm thick 1:4 cement plaster over ceiling
  - (h) Sanitary furnitures
  - (i) 100 mm dia Rain water pipe
  - (j) Providing and fixing of 5 mm glass in windows.

  - (b) 40 mm thick I.P.S. flooring.
