- 4. Has the judgement taken by the Delhi High Court on Section 377 impacted previously marginalized groups in a positive way? Discuss the impact, arguing for the significant role of Section 377 or its limitations.
- 5. Provide a broad outline of feminist intervention in the humanities, highlighting the gains made by feminist critique, and using examples from the work of feminist scholars.
- 6. "Post colonial feminism challenges many aspects of mainstream western feminism." Comment and discuss with the help of examples.
- 7. Explain Freud's theory of the Oedipus complex and show why and how feminist scholars have disagreed with this theory, with specific references to the work of Kate Millett and Nancy Chodorow?
- 8. Write short notes on any four of the following:
 - (a) Feminism and Colonialism
 - (b) Counter Cultural Essentialism
 - (c) Tebhaga Movement
 - (d) Division of Reality into Dichotomous Categories
