- 5. Discuss the priviledged position of English in the context of translation of literary texts.
- 6. Examine the formation of English Literature as a discipline in the context of England and that of colonial India.
- 7. Write a short essay on the links between 20 imperialism and canon formation.

- 8. What kind of *canon* does Miller's argument suggest? Or is it an attack on all *canons*? Discuss.
- 9. Compare Premchand's writing with that of Mulk Raj Anand and Raja Rao and investigate the ways in which they come to terms with the problem of language and reader from their respective positions.
- 10. How does Said define Orientalism? What are the flaws, or loop holes, in Said's argument? Do they seriously undermine his argument?
