- 1. Discuss the main provisions of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956.
- **2.** Evaluate the duties of NGOs as provided under the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956.
- 3. Discuss the importance of Synergy in the area of Human Trafficking.
