- **14.** Give a description of the authorities appointed under the wild life Protection Act, 1972.
- **15.** Describe the powers and functions of the National Tiger Conservation Authority established under the wild life Protection Act, 1972.
- **16.** Discuss the main features of the National Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy, 2007.

- 18. Give a critical overview of the scheduled tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers Act, 2006. Discuss the factors which led to the passing of this Act.
- 19. "Displacement and Rehabilitation are two sides of the same coin". Explain the above statement.
- **20.** Critically evaluate the main provisions of the Panchayats Extension to the Scheduled Areas Act, 1996.
