 - (c) The client moves into a building without securing the building completion/occupancy certificate.
 - (d) In a large scale project where multiple agencies are involved and the architect being the main coordinator of consultants, the electrical services fail causing loss to the client.

- (e) An architect wishes to enter into an agreement with a foreign architect to provide services in India.
- (f) An architect sub commissions work to another architect without agreement with the client.
- (g) An architect has been selected to work on a project in a foreign country.
