- (b) When all your alchemy and your algebra, Your minerals, vegetals, and animals, Your conjuring, cozening, and your dozens of trades,
 Could not relieve your corpse with so much linen.
- (c) They know and do not know, what it is to act or suffer
 They know and do not know, that acting is suffering
 And suffering is action.
- (d) I'm in the fire and I'm burning, and all I want is to die ! ... But what does it matter — this is what he wanted from me !
- (e) Astride of a grave and difficult birth. Down in the hole, lingeringly, the grave-digger puts on the forceps. We have time to grow old. The air is full of our cries. But habit is a great deadener.
