- 3. Define the term 'Cognizable Offence'. Discuss the Powers and Duties of the Police concerning these offences.
- Discuss the functions of public prosecutors. Briefly explain the procedure for appointing of public prosecutors and additional public prosecutors at district level.
- 5. Write a note on the International trend on the subject of role of victims in Criminal Justice System and justification for compensation to victims.

**6.** Explain the Constitutional rights of an accused with the help of decided case laws.

- 1. Define the term 'Charge'. Discuss the rationale behind the provisions relating to framing of charges.
- 2. Discuss the philosophy behind the scheme underlying provisions section 24 and 25 of CrPC, 1973 seperating prosecution from Investigation Machinery.
- 3. Discuss the concept of fair trial in India with the help of Judicial decisions.
- 4. Discuss the special care prescribed to be taken by Jail authorities for the women prisoners during their imprisonment.
- 5. Discuss the law relating to investigation of Cognizable Offences under the CrPC, 1973.
- 6. Discuss the law relating to bails in India with the help of Judicial decisions.

#### PART - C

Answer any two of the following questions in about 500 words. Each question carries 20 marks: 2x20=40

- 1. What are the various alternatives to imprisonment under Indian Law? Why they are preferred over imprisonment?
- 2. What is FIR? Who and in what form can he lodge an FIR? Discuss the evidentiary value of FIR.
- 3. Discuss the conditions under which compensation can be awarded to the victim under the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- **4.** Write notes on **any two** of the following:
  - (a) Women prisoners and their Human Rights.
  - (b) The contribution of the Supreme Court of India in protecting the Rights of the children of women prisoners.
