4. Discuss the special care prescribed to be taken by Jail authorities for the women prisoners during their imprisonment.
5. Discuss the law relating to investigation of Cognizable Offences under the CrPC, 1973.
6. Discuss the law relating to bails in India with the help of Judicial decisions.
