

- Draw exterior and interior tangents to two circles 14 of unequal radii.
- Draw a regular hexagon of side 30 mm. Draw a 14 circle passing through all corners of hexagon.
- 3. A cone of base diameter of 40 mm and height 60 mm rests with its base on H.P. It is cut by a plane passing through middle of the axis, making an angle of 45° with HP and perpendicular to V.P. Develop the cone surface.
- 4. An ellipse has the major axis and minor axis in the ratio of 3:2. Draw the ellipse when the major axis is 120 mm. Draw a tangent and a normal at any point P on it.

5. Figure - 1 shows certain machine block. Draw front and top views.



6. A circular plate of 60 mm diameter, has a hexagonal hole of 20 mm side, centrally punched. Draw the projections of the plate, resting on H.P. On a point, with its surface inclined at 30° to HP. Any two parallel sides of the hexagonal hole are perpendicular to V.P. Draw the projections of the plate.

7. Draw the development of a cylinder of 50 mm diameter and 75 mm height, containing a square hole of 25 mm side. The sides of the hole are equally inclined to the base and the axis of the hole bisects the axis of the cylinder.


