Note: Attempt any four questions from this part. Each question carries 10 marks. 4x10=40 (not exceeding 500 words)

- 1. Differentiate between Intention and Knowledge.
- 2. "Act of the accused not punishable for attempt to commit an offence where the act is intrinsically useless or defective". Discuss.
- 3. Right of Private defence is only available to the defender and not to the offender. Discuss.
- 4. Write a note on Burden of Proof in criminal trial.
- 5. Write a note on the offence of Murder with illustrations.
- 6. Write a note on the object behind Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

PART - 'C'

Note: Attempt any two questions from this part. Each question carries 20 marks. 2x20=40 (not exceeding 1500 words)

- **2.** When does the Right of Private Defence of Property and body become inseparable? Discuss.
- 3. Bring out the distinction between Murder and culpable Homicide not amounting to murder under IPC with the help of decided cases.
