- 5. State the meaning and importance of 'prospectus'. What are its contents? Outline the liability for mis-statements in a prospectus.
- 6. (a) Briefly state the characteristics of a negotiable instrument. What are its types?
  - (b) How would you distinguish between a bill of exchange and a cheque?
- 7. Define 'implied conditions and warranties'. State the various implied conditions and warranties in a contract of sale of goods.

  - (c) Position of directors
  - (d) Dishonour of cheque for insufficiency of funds.
