4. Discuss the causes of delay in the criminal Justice Process and the measures to address it.
5. What are the International Norm Pertaining to the control of Police and Prison authorities ?
6. What are the advantages of Electronic Court Management in the Criminal Justice system.

PART - B

Attempt *any four* questions in about 500 words. Each question carries 10 marks.

1. What is democratic Policing ? What is the significance of transparency and accountability in the police system ?
2. What is Community Policing ? How it is linked with democratic Policing.
3. Discuss the main provision of the prisons act, 1894.
4. Discuss in brief the visitorial system in India.
5. Describe the hierarchy of courts in the criminal Justice system in India.
6. What is a Post-Mortem Report ? Discuss the purpose of conducting Post-Mortem.

PART - C

Attempt *any two* questions in about **1500** words. Each question carries **20** marks.

1. Critically evaluate the various rights available to prisoners. How the judiciary has widened the scope of those rights.
 2. Analyse the various theories of punishments. Discuss the sentencing guidelines of UK, USA and India.
 3. What do you understand by the term 'Scientific Evidence' ? What are the factors affecting the efficacy of scientific evidence ?
 4. What do you understand by the term 'withdrawal of prosecution' ? What are the condition for the withdrawal of prosecution.
