3. Is decentralisation pro-poor ? Discuss.
4. Write a note on sanctuary and restrictions inside a sanctuary.
5. What are the powers and functions of the Wildlife Crime Control Bureau?
6. Comment on social impact due to displacement.

## PART - C

Attempt any 2 questions from this part. Each question carries 20 marks.

1. Describe the main features of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980. How it differs from the earlier Act of 1927 ?
2. What are the factors which need to be kept in consideration when a mass displacement occurs ? Discuss.
3. Is displacement avoidable? Quote some of the projects which could have been avoided and displacement stopped in national context.
4. Is it justifiable to say that displacement and rehabilitation are two sides of same coin? Why should rehabilitation be considered? Discuss.
