2. Answer the following question in about 600 words :

Explain in detail Michael Moore's motion of independent study.

OR

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Differentiate with examples between the Charles Wedemeyer's motion of independent study and conventional classroom situation.

 - (a) Distinguish between the term 'Open education' and Distance Education.
 - (b) List the main characteristics of distance education as discussed by Keegan.
 - (c) Discuss the pedagogic aspects of Otto Peters' theory in relation to distance education.
 - (d) Discuss pedagogic significance of tutor comments on assignments in distance education.
 - (e) State the importance of staff development in distance education.
 - (f) Differentiate between 'real' and 'simulated' didactic conversation as identified by Holmberg.

4. Answer the following question in about 600 words :

Analyse the quality issues in different areas of open and distance education. Write suggestions on these issues.

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
