 Discuss development of education during medieval and modern India, underlining the focus that education received during Muslim, preindependence and post independence periods.

OR

Discuss with concrete examples the role of community participation in educational development. How can better participation of community be ensured in this regard?

- 3. Attempt *any four* of the following in about 150 words each:
  - (a) Concept and characteristics of a 'learning society'.
  - (b) International cooperation for universalization of elementary education in India.
  - (c) Reciprocity of influence between education and social change.
  - (d) Major political decisions relating to education taken after Kothari Commission's report.
  - (e) Constitutional provisions of education in India.
  - (f) Meaning of the four pillars of education an enunciated in Delors Commissions report, 'Learning the Treasure Within'.
