Bihar has been prone to flooding. When last year the floods came it was dubbed as "the worst in living memory". This time it was declared "catastrophic" a "national calamity, and "deluge".

The scale of the floods this year was beyond imagination. Now, after three weeks, the flowing waters are still swallowing up men and material. It is also unlike Bihar's annual floods, with the Kosi, the most ferocious river of the state inundating those areas that had not seen flooding for the last 50 years.

The people of Supaul, Saharsa, Purnea, Madhepura Araria and Khagaria districts were
not prepared for the calamity. The flooding happened suddenly on August 18, submerging houses and making people flee. The Kosi's embankment breached at Kusaha in Nepal, and this was allowed to happen despite early warnings. The river of sorrow, as the kosi is known in Bihar, found a new course and new victims. Even as the Government and people realised the intensity of the calamity, the breach had become 3 km wide.

About 26 lakh people have been affected. Everywhere in the flood-hit areas, community participation and the help of the army was the one silver lining. The situation on the ground level was bad. The relief godowns were full but the poor flood-hit people were far from receiving this relief. It was the local community participation and the army that kept the starving flood victims alive. At one place even students were seen serving food, milk and drinking water.
