A two day conference to showcase cutting edge science by women scientists in India opened here today, providing a rare glimpse of women who are helping build India's, defence and warfare system. Dividing time between home and the workplace they are designing combat aircraft, debugging missiles control software or developing electronic warfare systems.

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has 950 women an among it's scientific workforce of 7,000.

"Women scientists in the DRDO enjoy the challenges and the benefits of working in cutting adge technology", said Nabanita Krishnan, a scientist at the DRDO head quarters.
