1. Annotate *any four* of the following passages with reference to the context in not more than 150 words each : 4x5=20
- (a) Sweet Mephistophilis, thou pleasest me;

with all things that delight the heart of man
my four and twenty years of liberty I'll
spend in pleasure and in dalliance.
- (b) Murder most foul, as in the best it is, But
this most foul, strange and unnatural...O,
horrible ? O, horrible ? Most horrible ! If
thou hast nature in thee, bear it not, let not
the royal bed of Denmark bell Adieu, adieu,
adieu, remember me.

- (c) What am I fit for ? What have you left me fit for ? Where am I to go ? What am I to do ? What's to become of me ?
- (d) I'm in the fire and I'm burning, and all I want is to die ? But what does it matter - and this is what he wanted from me ? Don't you see ? I'm in the Mud at last ? I'm grovelling ? I'm crawling ? Oh, God"
- (e) Estragon : Let's hang ourselves immediately !
- Vladimir : From a bough ? I wouldn't trust.
- Estragon : We can always try.
- Vladimir : Go ahead.
- Estragon : After you.
- Vladimir : No,no,you first.

Estragon : If it hangs you, it will hang anything.
