- 2. Examine the strategies and approaches to restore incomes of Project Affected Persons (PAPs). Discuss the essential factors necessary for income generation programmes meant for them.
- 3. What do you understand by the capacity building programmes for PAPs? Discuss the salient features of such programmes for those who opt for non-land based rehabilitation.

- Write an essay highlighting the main components of planning and designing a training programme for PAPs.
- 5. What are the cost considerations in a resettlement process? Identify the main categories of resettlement and rehabilitation related costs of a development project.
- 6. Define a project and discuss the steps involved in planning for implementation of a project.
- 7. Describe the reasons for monitoring the resettlement and rehabilitation programmes and discuss the quality of information needed to monitor such programmes.
- 8. Explain how resource planning for rehabilitation is a critical factor in timely completion of development projects.
