3. Write a note on Philosophy and aim of Restorative Justice.
4. What are the components of the Criminal Justice System ?
5. Describe briefly the genesis of The Police System in India.
6. Write a note on presumption of Innocence.

Attempt *any two* questions from this Part. Each question carries **20** marks. (*not exceeding 1500 words*) **2x20=40**

 3. Discuss the fundamental duties enshrined in part IV of the constitution of India.
