He has been taking over the counter medications since 3 months but has not seen any improvement in the symptoms. Since past one week attendants have noted that he has mild noise while taking breath.

1) Answer the following questions within 750 words.

- a) A 70 year old female patient presents with continuous cough and pain in right side of chest, low grade fever, severe weight loss and anorexia since a month. Her daughter in law reported that she had been fasting for 9 days for religious reasons and is in the habit of taking bath in cold water early in the morning, though there was a chill in the weather. Daughter in law also said that the patient had always been lean and thin.
- b) A 65-year-old lady presents to the emergency room with a sudden onset of severe vertigo associated with vomiting. What examinations would you perform on this patient? What seems to be the likely diagnosis?
  Hints: examination should be performed. Central nervous system cause of vertigo, such as stroke event seems likely.
