1) Answer the following questions within 750 words.

(2 X20=40)

- A. A 63 year old male presents with a report of less than 0.01 mu/l. How will you processed next?
- B. A 65 years old gentleman, known case of diabetes since 30 years, on regular medications for the same, presented with complaints of pain, discharge and reduced hearing in the right ear since 10 days. He has been visiting the physician regularly for routine examinations and the laboratory examinations are in normal range for his age. He gives a past history of discharge from the same ear few years back which was relieved with medications. On examination there is mucoid discharge in the ear. After cleaning the discharge there is a central perforation of the tympanic membrane. Tuning fork tests reveal conductive type of hearing loss in the right ear and normal hearing in the left ear.
 - a. What is the provisional diagnosis?
 - b. What investigations would you order?
 - c. What Medications would you prescribe?
 - d. What will the further management plan?
 - e. What surgical intervention would you advise to the patient?
 - f. Write a short note on the management of the fungal infections- dermatophytes and candidiasis in the elderly.

A 70-year-old man with unilateral hand tremors of 4 months duration visited a neurosurgeon and was prescribed amantadine 200 mg twice daily, pramipexole 1 mg daily, trihexyphenidyl 2 mg thrice daily. The patient presents to your emergency room in delirium with a 3-day history of gradual decline.
 - What may be the possible causes of the same? How would you approach the patient?
- B. A 65 year old male patient presented with intense low back ache, fatigue and loss of weight since last one month. He also complains of urinary problems like hesitancy and nocturia. His X ray shows collapse of L 4-5 vertebrae. He was given pain killers advised rest and referred for physiotherapy by local health care provider would you like to change the management protocol?
