#### 1) Answer the following questions within 750 words.

- a) An elderly man is brought by his family to emergency room in semiconscious and disoriented state. He has been suffering from diarrhea for last 3 days. His comorbid illnesses are DM, hypertension. Of late his family has been observing some forgetfulness. How will you proceed for assessment of dehydration. What are the risk factors for dehydration in this patient?
- b) A 71-year-old female with longstanding history of episodic non-bilious projectile vomiting (mostly undigested food and saliva) presented with worsening of her symptoms and food intolerance during the previous six months. Over that time frame, she noted a sensation of food becoming stuck in her throat and progressive difficulty swallowing. This difficulty was initially related to solids and then progressively to liquids, which severely limited her food intake. She lost 8 kg since the symptoms started to worsen. She stays alone and does not smoke or drink alcohol. Her family history is non-contributory. Evaluation of her upper GI endoscopy showed dilated esophagus and pooling of saliva and a tight GE junction. The barium swallow demonstrated dilated mid-distal esophagus with "bird beaking" appearance.

Questions: What is the likely diagnosis? What test is needed to confirm the diagnosis? Outline the common modalities of management.

How would you evaluate him further, treat and prevent further similar occurrences?
- b) Mrs. R, 86-year-old lady, who is living alone presented to the clinic other with her son in law, with short term memory loss. She was able to give a detailed history, but struggled with other details of the past and at times inaccurate. Her main hobby was cooking and reading newspapers, now a days she is facing difficulty in completing the tasks. She is also not able to remember any major events from the newspaper. She is also forgetting scheduled family meetings like going to temple or shopping, and going for a wedding. She once went to the nearby shop, forget her way to return back to the home.

The family is worried and her older sister was diagnosed as dementia.

What is the diagnosis? How will you proceed?
