Answer any five questions. All questions carry equal marks. (20x 5= 100)

- 1. Discuss the required insights of a language learner, not only as a cognitive entity, but as a social being functioning in a multilingual environment.
- 2. Do you think that language as a dynamic entity, subject to variation and change? Justify your answer with examples.
- 3. What are the new theories that are prevalent in terms of the learners, the learning process, classroom management, materials selection and creation, evaluation and methodology of teaching?
- 4. What are the effective methods and strategies used in teaching-learning the different skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing? Are there more interesting and effective ways of classroom organization and management?
- 5. What are the challenges faced by the teachers and the learners in making formal grouporiented instruction which are sensitive to individual needs? What are the varied resources children bring to class that need to be recognized and built upon?
- 6. What does the 'critical age for language acquisition' mean? Discuss language system as interlanguage by Larry Selinker (1972), transitional competence (Pit Corder), or approximate system.
- 7. When does fossilization take place? Can you give examples of certain sounds or grammatical items that have got fossilized in the Indian context?
- 8. What are the five processes involved in the learning of second language. Elucidate with case studies.
- 9. Discuss your ideas on "Indian English". Justify your dialogue with a couple of case studies.

Answer any five questions. All questions carry equal marks. (20x 5= 100)

- 1. What do you understand by the term 'text'? How is a text organized?
- 2. Overt linguistic devices are not always required to understand the meaning a text. Give an instance from your language when the socio-cultural context clearly provides the required information to understand a text.
- 3. What are the three factors that connect a text? Of these factors which one do you think is most important in understanding text?
- 4. What are the relationships between linguistic elements and the role they perform in certain contextual situations?
- 5. As a teacher do you think there are limitations in teaching sentence based grammar? How would incorporating a discourse perspective help your students?
- 6. What are the three areas which discourse covers with regard to language teaching?
- 7. What is meant by 'co-text' and the 'context of the situation'? What are their component features?
- 8. Discuss the major derivational suffixes of English and classify them according to the scheme of classification.
- 9. Discuss the sound and spelling in English. Examine the symbols for the consonants and talk about the sound each symbol stands for.

- 3. Explain the main features of language learning through the structural approach.

- 6. Describe the salient features of the Humanistic approach to language teaching.
- 7. What does ICT mean? What are the implications of ICT for education and especially for teaching of English?

- 9. Critically examine the terms Authenticity, Practicality, Reliability, Validity and Washback vis-a-vis the History of Language Tests and Assessments.
