1. Which of the following statements are true? Justify your answers: (10)
 - i) If a function f from \mathbf{R} to \mathbf{R} is such that $|f|$ is continuous, then f is also continuous.
 - ii) The function f , defined by $f(x) = x + \sin x$, is monotonic in $\left[-\frac{\pi}{2}, \frac{\pi}{2}\right]$.
 - iii) $\int_0^3 |x-1| dx = \frac{3}{2}$.
 - iv) $\frac{d}{dx} \left[\int_x^{e^x} \ln t dt \right] = xe^x - \ln x$.
 - v) $y(x^2 + 4) = 2$ has oblique asymptotes.
2.
 - a) If $y = \ln \left[x + \sqrt{x^2 + 1} \right]$, check whether $(1+x^2)y_{n+2} + (2n+1)xy_{n+1} - n^2y_n = 0$ is true or not. (5)
 - b) Find lower and upper integrals of f , defined on $[-1, 1]$, by
$$f(x) = \begin{cases} 1, & \text{if } x \text{ is rational} \\ 2, & \text{if } x \text{ is irrational} \end{cases}$$
Hence, check the integrability of f on $[-1, 1]$. (5)

 - a) Check whether the function f , defined by $f(x) = \cos x - \cos 3x$, is periodic or not. (3)
 - b) By dividing the interval $[0, 4]$ into 4 equal parts, find the approximate value of $\int_0^4 \frac{dx}{x+1}$, using Simpson's rule. (4)
 - c) Differentiate $\sin^{-1} x$ with respect to $\cos^{-1}(\sqrt{1-x^2})$. (3)

 - a) If, for $n \geq 1$, $I_n = \int_0^{\frac{\pi}{2}} \cos^n x \cos nx dx$, find the value of $2I_{n+1} - I_n$. Hence, evaluate I_2 . (5)
 - b) Find the derivative of $(\tan x)^{\sec x} + (\sec x)^{\cot x}$ with respect to x . (5)

 - a) Trace the curve $x^2 = y^2(x+1)^3$, stating all the properties used in the process. (10)
6.
 - b) State Lagrange's Mean Value Theorem and use it to prove that

$$1 + x < e^x < 1 + xe^x, \forall x > 0. \quad (6)$$

b) Evaluate: $\int \frac{3\sin x + 2\cos x}{3\cos x + 2\sin x} dx.$ (4)

7. a) Find the volume of the solid generated by the revolution of the curve $(a - x)y^2 = a^2x$ about its asymptote. (6)

b) A function f is defined on \mathbf{R} by

$$f(x) = \begin{cases} C^2x, & \text{if } x \leq 1 \\ 5Cx - 6, & \text{if } x > 1 \end{cases}$$

Determine the value(s) of C so that f becomes continuous on \mathbf{R} . (4)

8. a) Find the area of one arch of the cycloid $x = a(t - \sin t)$, $y = a(1 - \cos t)$ bounded by its base. (5)

b) Evaluate $\int \frac{(x^2 - 1)}{x^4 + x^2 + 1} dx.$ (3)

c) Find the values of $(0.98)^{5/2}$ upto 3 decimal places. (2)

9. a) Find the area included between the parabolas $y^2 = 4x$ and $x^2 = 4y$. (5)

b) If $I_n = \int_{\pi/4}^{\pi/2} \cot^n x dx$, then prove that $(n - 1)(I_n + I_{n-2}) = 1$. (5)

10. a) Differentiate $\sin^{-1} x$ with respect to $\cos^{-1} \sqrt{1 - x^2}$. (2)

b) Evaluate: $\int \frac{1 + x^2}{1 + 7x^2 + x^4} dx.$ (4)

c) Find the equation of the tangent and the normal to the curve $x^2 + y^2 + 4x + 3y - 25 = 0$ at $(-3, 4)$. (4)
