The introduction must offer your brief interpretation of the question and how you propose to develop it. The conclusion must summaries your answer to the question.

Make sure that your answer

• Is logical and coherent; has clear connections between sentences and paragraphs; Is written correctly giving adequate consideration to your expression, style and presentation.
