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INSTRUCTION FOR ASSIGNMENTS

As a part of PGDPM Programme, each candidate has to do one Tutor Marked Assignment (TMA), in all the four courses except course MAMP – 001: Project Work. These TMAs comprise theoretical as well as practical assignments.

Assignments carry 30% weightage in the continuous evaluation process of a course. The term-end examinations carry 70% weightage.

The assignments will be evaluated by the Counsellors at the study centre and the respective weightage of marks will be added to their percentage of marks obtained at the term-end examination. Each candidate will have to complete assignments in order to appear in the term-end examination. Candidates are, therefore, advised to take assignments seriously and submit them in time.

- 1) The validity of the assignment is ONE YEAR. If you fail to submit the assignments before the due date, you are supposed to attempt the fresh set of assignments of next year (e.g. if a student of July 2018 session fails to submit his/her assignments within the due dates, he/she will have to attempt the fresh assignments of July 2019 session).

- 4. What is plucking in tea? Discuss the growth rhythm of shoots and plucking styles in tea.
