3. Answer any four of the following questions in about 150 words each :
- (a) Differentiate between instructional objectives and terminal behaviour. Give examples.
  - (b) Discuss briefly any three teaching competencies expected of a higher education teacher.
  - (c) What are the modes of Computer Assisted Learning (CAL)? Describe any three of these modes.
  - (d) State the factors which affect the reliability of a test.
  - (e) Differentiate between Z score and T score.
  - (f) Differentiate between marking and grading. Which one of these will you prefer and why?

Select a topic of your choice from a subject at college level. Prepare ten frames of programmed learning material using linear style. Describe the stages you followed while developing the programmed learning materials.

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
