2. Visit the IIPA Library Website at [http:// www.iipalibrary.in](http://www.iipalibrary.in) 5x2=10
- Find out the online e-resources subscribed by the library.
  - Find out the alerting services rendered by the library.
  - Identify the World Bank e-library resources.
  - Search from the World Bank e-library and find out the book titled "The day after tomorrow" and note down its author, ISBN and total number of pages.
  - Show from where you can download the abstract of the above retrieved book.
3. Find out the URL of main 'Elsevier' site. 10
- List the journals published by Elsevier in the area of 'Library and Information Science.'
  - Select any one of the above journals and identify its Impact factor score.
  - Find out the editor of the journal.
  - Go to the contents of its latest issue and save the page.
