5. Answer the following : 5+5=10

Sonu is 1 year old. He weighs 9 kg and is brought with complaint of fever for last 2 days. The doctor checked for general danger signs. Sonu is able to drink, has not had vomiting, has not had convulsions and is not lethargic or unconscious. Sonu does not have cough or difficult breathing or diarrhoea. Because sonu's temperature is 38°C and he feels hot, the doctor assessed sonu further for signs related to fever. It is the rainy season and the risk of Malaria is high. Sonu has still neck and bulging fontanelle. Sonu does not have runny nose. He does not have measles now or in the last 3 months. Sonu does not have ear problem. Sonu is not low weight for age and has some pallor.
