OR

Discuss the philosophy and aims of education according to Idealistic and Pragmatic schools of thought. Are they relevant to the present system of education? Discuss.

 - (a) Define Curriculum. Explain major view points of curriculum.
 - (b) How is curriculum planned at the national and the state level? Explain with an example from our Indian context.
 - (c) What is curriculum evaluation? Explain the different phases of curriculum evaluation.
 - (d) What are the aims of Education according to the National Curriculum framework (2005)? To what extent are they reflected in our school curriculum?
 - (e) Explain the Pancha Koshas (five sheaths) and their aims in all round development of an individual.
 - (f) Explain the Buddhist theory of Causation.
