2. Ajay, a 22-year-old male, has been admitted with Traumatic pneumothorax following chest injury.
- (a) List the signs and symptoms of traumatic pneumothorax.
 - (b) Explain the treatment modalities for Ajay.
 - (c) How will you, as a nurse, assess that the patient is developing flail chest ? $3+5+7=15$
3. Mr. Jagmohan, a 62-year-old male, is admitted with the diagnosis of Myocardial Infarction. Discuss his condition under the following headings : $5+5+10=20$
- (a) Pathophysiology of Myocardial Infarction
 - (b) Clinical manifestations of Myocardial Infarction
 - (c) Therapeutic and Nursing Management in Myocardial Infarction

Mrs. Shobha Devi, a 48-year-old female, was operated for Space Occupying Lesion. She develops raised intracranial pressure during the post-operative period.

- (a) What are the clinical manifestations in raised intracranial pressure ?
