Soni is 13 months old. She weighs 10 kg and is brought with complaints of fever and cough for two days. The doctor checked for general danger signs. Soni is not able to drink and confirmed also she has not had vomiting, has not had convulsions and is not lethargic or unconscious. On assessment for cough or difficult breathing, her breathing rate is 62 per minute and she has chest drawing and stridor. She does not have diarrhoea. On assessment for fever, the risk of malaria is high. Soni does not have stiff neck or bulging fontanelle. She does not have measles now or in the last 3 months. Soni does not have ear problem. She is not low weight for age and has some pallor.
