 - (e) Compound, Coordinate and Subordinate bilinguals
 - (f) The Anglicist – Orientalist Debate
2. Discuss the role of Aptitude, Attitude and Motivation in learning English. You may give examples from the classroom. 20

3. Language is not a static entity but subject to variation. What are the social, personal and geographical factors which lead to variation ? Discuss with examples. 20
 4. Why do languages change ? Discuss this phenomenon with respect to the English language. Give examples wherever necessary. 20
 5. What were the limitations of the Contrastive analysis approach ? How did the new perspectives on errors help ? Discuss. 20
 6. Discuss the difference between code-mixing and code-switching. Should the mother tongue be used in the English classroom ? Why/Why not ? 20
 7. What do you know about the Three-Language Formula ? Has it been successfully implemented ? Discuss. 20
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
