- **1.** Answer any *one* of the following questions in about 1200 words:
 - (a) Explain the relevance of behaviouristic theory of learning for designing instructions for distance learners. Discuss the implications of behaviouristic theories in the context of Open and Distance Learning (ODL).
 - (b) Discuss the contributions of Component Display Theory (CDT) of instructional design. Discuss the recent developments (pebble-in-the-pond) of instructional design theory of David Merrill.

- **2.** Answer any *four* of the following questions in about 300 words each:
 - (a) What is Learning Style? Discuss briefly the different components of Dunn and Dunn model of learning styles.
 - (b) Differentiate between formative and summative assessment of learning. Discuss briefly how formative assessment is carried out while designing instructional materials for distance learning.
 - (c) What is Rapid Prototyping? Discuss briefly the implications of rapid prototyping model for designing instruction.
 - (d) Explain the difference between 'Education' and 'Training'. Discuss the various steps involved in designing a training programme in open and distance learning.
 - (e) Discuss the significance of access devices in open and distance learning materials. Give examples.
 - (f) Critically examine the implications of David Ausubel's theory of advance organisers for designing instruction.

- **3.** Answer any *one* of the following questions in about 1200 words:
 - (a) Describe the various components of story boarding. Explain how these components are used for designing e-Learning content for distance learners.
 - (b) Select a topic of your choice and prepare a self-learning unit involving various steps of instructional design.
