2. What is 'confession' and explain when confession is not admissible in evidence ?
3. What is Restorative Justice ? Explain its limitations.
4. Write a note on the concept of Correctional Process.
5. Discuss conflict theories.
6. Write a note on Biological factors and criminal behaviour.

PART - C

Attempt *any two* questions from this part. Each question carries 20 marks (not exceeding 1500 words) 2x20=40

1. Discuss Psychoanalytical theories of crime and criticism against it.

 - (b) Universality of Human Rights

 3. What are the Rights of the Accused under the constitution of India and various enactments ?
